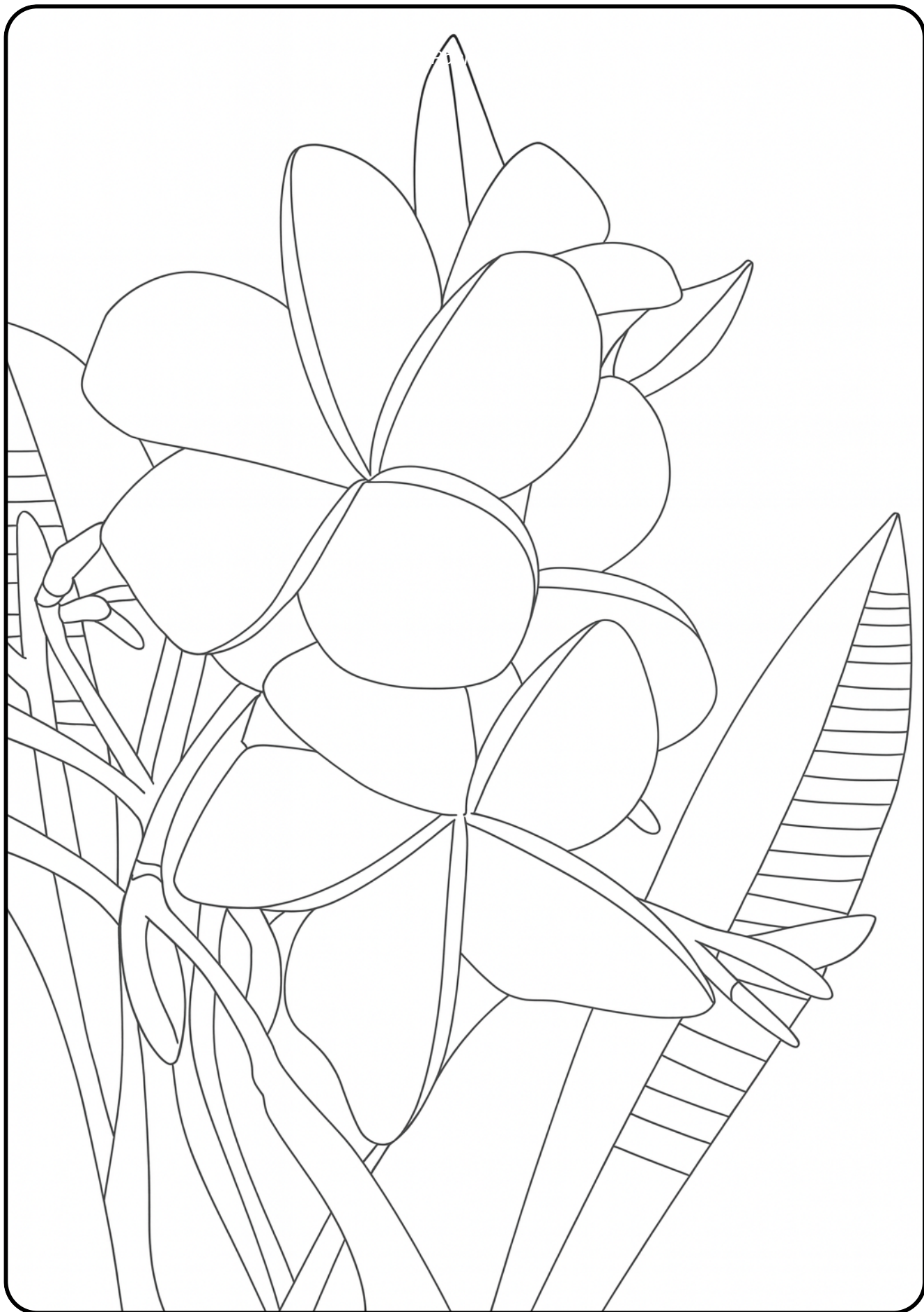
Medium: Pitt Pastel on Pastelmat

Tips for the Artist – Positive Plumeria

- Layer your colors gently — start light and add depth with richer yellows and whites.
- Notice how the edges of each petal catch the light — leave some paper showing to keep highlights bright.
- Shade softly into the centers of the petals to give them roundness and dimension.
- Pay attention to the background — a dark tone makes the flowers pop, while a light wash creates a gentler mood.



Tips for the Artist – Positive Plumeria

- Most importantly, let this flower feel uplifting – your colors can carry the joy of spring.
